### **“Our Hearts Long for Relationship With Our Maker”**

Week 5 | Week of June 25 2017 | Psalm 139

Read Psalm 139.

1. Who knows (or knew) you the best? What made you willing to share who you are with those people? Are there things that those people do not know about you?
2. What person or people do you feel you know the best? Are there things about them that remain a mystery to you?
3. How does David feel about God's total knowledge of him? Is he “of two minds” about the fact that nothing is hidden from God?
4. Does the truth that God knows everything about you make you rejoice, feel exposed, feel claustrophobic, or feel something else?
5. Do you ever desire to escape God's expectations or God's presence? What does that reveal concerning how you feel about God's character or God's commandments?
6. Does any human relationship resemble your relationship with God? In what ways?
7. In what moments of your life have you found yourself most longing for connection with God? In what moments or seasons have you found yourself least interested in recognizing God's presence? What do those moments and seasons tell you about your heart's longing for relationship with God?
8. Are you willing to ask God to “search your thoughts” and your motives? What do you risk when you invite God to help you get honest about the things in your life that may need to be addressed?
