“When Jesus Is My King, My Lord, My Sovereign”

Week 3 | November 5, 2017 | 1 Timothy 6:2b-19

1. Who is the most powerful person you have ever met or known?
What gave that person such authority?
2. How do you tend to react to those in positions of worldly power?
Do you find yourself drawn to them, distrustful of them, interested in trying to influence them?
3. Read 1 Timothy 6:11-15. Why do you think Paul here reminds Timothy of Timothy's confession of Jesus Christ as lord, of Christ's profession of his identity before Pilate, and of the Cosmic reign of Jesus Christ? Do you ever need to be reminded of these things?
4. What does it mean in your life right now to “fight the good fight of faith” (v.12) – is growing in generosity a place where that fight is taking place for you?
5. What decisions or areas of your life reveal Christ as the Lord of your life?
In what areas could the group help you grow in making Christ the King of your life?
6. As we conclude this series on Paul's instructions to Timothy about money, what has been significant to you?
7. In your current approach to giving, is giving a passion for you?
Does giving feel like an act of worship to you? Does it bring you joy?
